PURPOSE: Provide a clear pathway to engage and develop leaders across generations and contexts @ KCC.

The Bible gives us clear guidance on what right leadership both looks like and is grounded in. Most important we see it perfectly in the person and work of Jesus. Knowing what the Bible says about church leadership, helps us both identify and train current and future leaders.

Biblical leadership is a process whereby a person is being transformed by God from the inside out, as they influence a group of individuals, through discipleship, in community, for God's Kingdom mission.

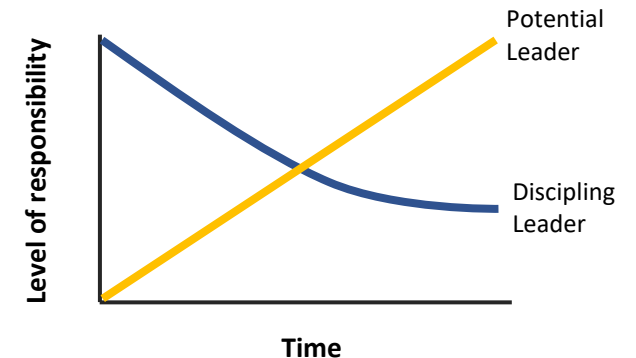
